

On May 13, 2017, a full-day workshop will be held: "*Designing Incentive Systems for the Millennial's Generation*", which will be attended by students of Poznan Universities and representatives of companies from the Wielkopolska Region Education and Economic Network. The workshops are organized by the TOP500 Innovators Association, in cooperation with the Poznan University of Technology - Faculty of Management Engineering as part of the Technical Knowledge Accelerator (AWT®) and the Poznan Supercomputing and Networking Center.

The challenge faced by this year's participants in Poznan Workshops is the attempt to find consensus among high expectations for employers by young generation entering the labor market (born in the years 1990 and 2000), and the possibility of their real fulfillment and understanding of Millennial's needs of employees of HR departments of the largest Wielkopolska Region Companies.

- will know the point of view of Wielkopolska Region key entrepreneurs, in relation to the challenges of the first job and the ability to meet the requirements of potential candidates by companies,
- will participate in the creation of innovative solutions that can be implemented by the key Wielkopolska Region companies.
